

Circularity Project Workshops – Crossborder Event for Pupils, Students, Professionals and Teachers

As part of the EDU-CIRC Community Events, **cross-border workshops** were organized for pupils, university students, teachers, and professionals to present and discuss innovative projects from schools, universities, and companies. Three workshops took place across South Tyrol, Carinthia, and Veneto, with a joint hybrid session held on 20 November 2025 that digitally connected all locations.

During the online session, participants from the three regions had the opportunity to learn about each other's projects and exchange insights. In total, **49 pupils, 4 teachers, 16 university students, and 4 professionals** took part. Nine groups presented their initiatives – two from South Tyrol, one from Carinthia, and six from Veneto – with topics ranging from biodegradable adhesives and recycling glulam to 3D printing life-cycle assessments and the “Spot the Green” challenge.

 The workshops offered participants a unique chance to engage in international exchange, explore a variety of projects, and present their work to diverse audiences from different regions. This experience not only strengthened cross-border collaboration but also allowed participants to gain new perspectives on sustainability practices and innovation in education and industry.
